



E-DESIGN: ICT TRAINING HOTSPOTS

Despite the unprecedented difficulties that had risen due to the Covid-19 pandemic, EILD managed to continue its 2nd ICT Training Hotspot in collaboration with the Municipality of Metamorfossi, in Attica, Greece. EILD is also moving forward to implementing the 3rd ICT Training Hotspot in collaboration with the Municipality of Palaio Faliro, in Attica, Greece. In both cases, the participants will receive free digital skills development courses, which will be held in 2 cycles. In order to maximize the attendance of the beneficiaries we decided to run a poll for those interested, in order to define the dates and times. Certificates of attendance will be issued by EILD.

MTG-Migrant Talent Garden

Always in the spirit of combating migrant youth unemployment, the MTG program creates a variety of actions, aiming not only to inform, but practically support young migrants wishing to develop and materialise their professional aspirations.



The business support network and training programme created specifically for the needs of the program, as well as the set up of an online migrant support platform and the establishment of migrant youth business support hubs in Northern and Southern Europe achieves to drastically confront the long-lasting issue of migrant unemployment and integration in the society. Throughout these actions, we are achieving a win-win situation, where, by tackling migrant unemployment, local entrepreneurship will be significantly boosted as well.





MIGRANT TAKE CARE

The Migrant Take Care program, which aimed at the social and labour inclusion of migrants with a low qualification level, has been completed with absolute success. The end of the program has been marked by an online event, hosted by EILD, where the program itself, and its completed actions were explicitly presented.

EMPOWERING WOMEN ATHLETES



Gender inequality in the world of sports has never been as accurate an issue as it is today. Action against violence and mistreatment towards women athletes is the cornerstone of the EWA program, a project determined to not only combat, but to defeat the unjust barriers set against women trying to thrive in the world of sports. Abuse, as we all know, can be far from evident. Profound violence, verbal, physical, sexual, emotional, psychological, social, cultural, organisational, economic, mediatic, is regularly reported, against (although not exclusively) female athletes. Co-founded by the European Commission through the Erasmus+ programme, the project aims to develop an active community of sport managers, policy makers and, evidently, female athletes, who will prevent harassment and discrimination in sport environments.

Education and knowledge on the matter, but also practical tools developed especially for the purposes of the project will contribute in the progressive confrontation of the matter. A petition on the issue will be raised and submitted to the EU that is participated by citizens in the European Union.
