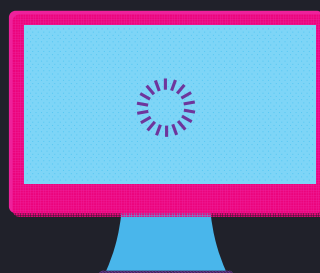
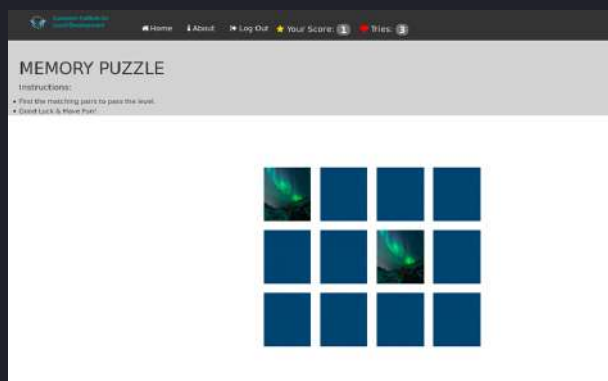
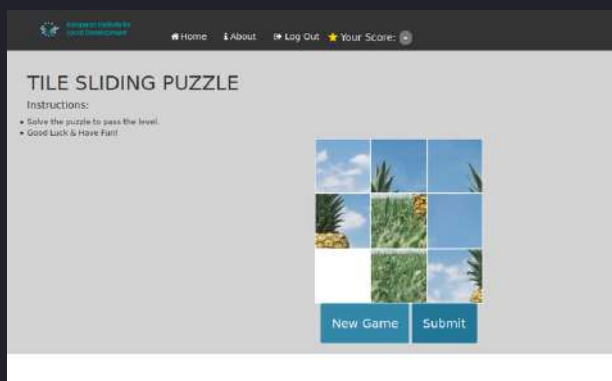
GAMIFICATION

The Institute so far this year has carried out a series of actions and initiatives both at local-regional and at national-european level. In the first six months of 2021, the Institute included in its assets eight new european projects, developed the network of strategic partners in 75 and holds monthly meetings with the 600 organizations with which it has collaborated and communicated since 2009.

Local Leadership for European Rural and Small Cities

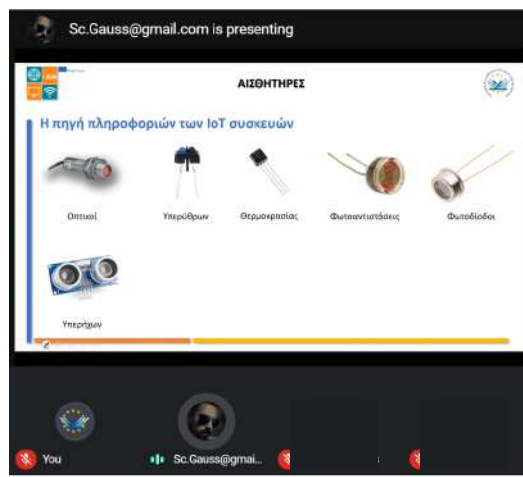


In the european project Local Leadership for European Rural and Small Cities, the Institute collaborates with 15 elected representatives from all over Greece in order to be trained on issues of concern to the current public administration and in collaboration with elected members from 5 countries to create a legal entity to apply for and propose solutions at european level.

Empowering Women Athletes: Tackling Feminine Abuse, Violence and Discrimination in EU Sports Clubs



In the european project Empowering Women Athletes: Tackling Feminine Abuse, Violence and Discrimination in EU Sports Clubs the Institute collaborates with the Hellenic Olympic Committee for the elaboration of a study and good practices for dealing with violence against women in sports along with a dynamic european consortium of 9 organizations.

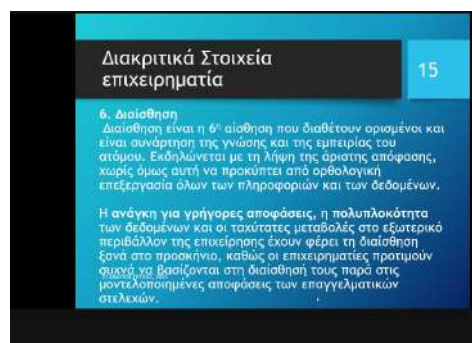


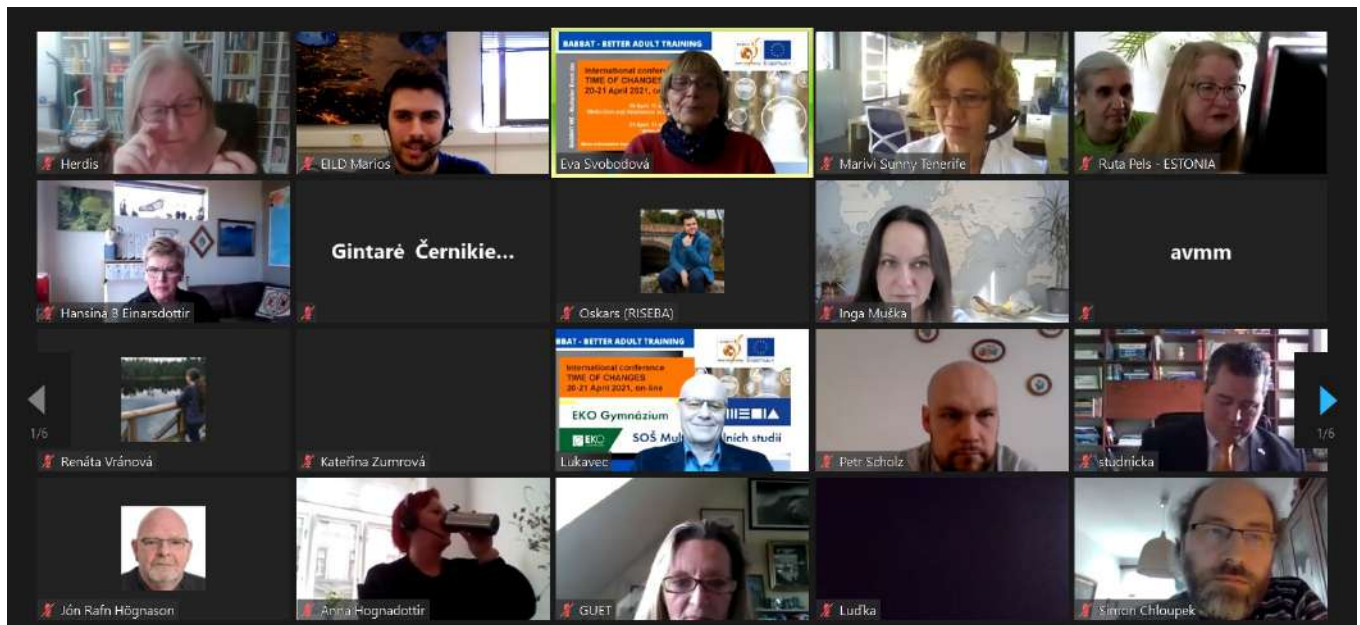

Migrant Talent Garden

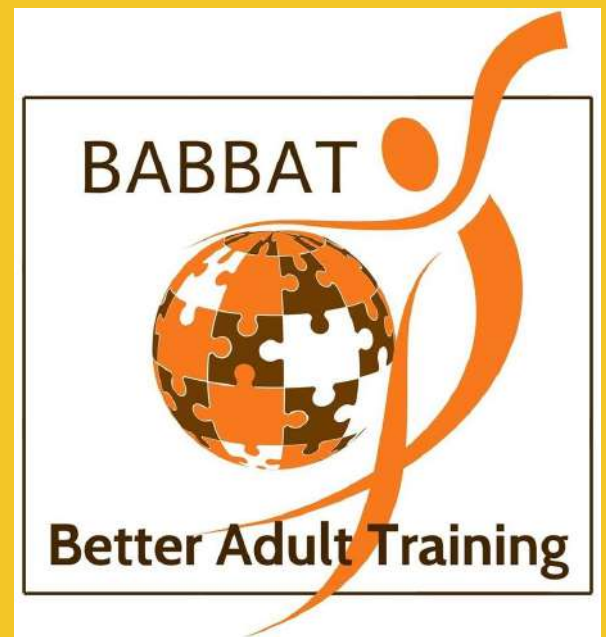

As part of the EEA Grants-funded MTG project, the Institute has developed a methodology and report on the needs of migrants in the countries of the consortium, including the Caritas of Norway and the Red Cross of Iceland. The Institute has conducted seminars for social workers on the topic of providing information on increasing the employment of immigrants and business consultants on how they can manage this special population group. The Institute has also held large seminars on entrepreneurship, having trained to date in all actions over 100 participants. The aim of the project is to create a business incubator with an innovative nomad hub methodology that has been developed entirely by the Institute team and is available to the public.





In the BABBAT project the Institute participated in a massive conference addressing adult education and life-long learning issues, where more than 220 experts and stakeholders participated in its 2 days of realization. As part of the project we have created toolboxes and methodologies of good practices in order to promote lifelong learning and its importance.

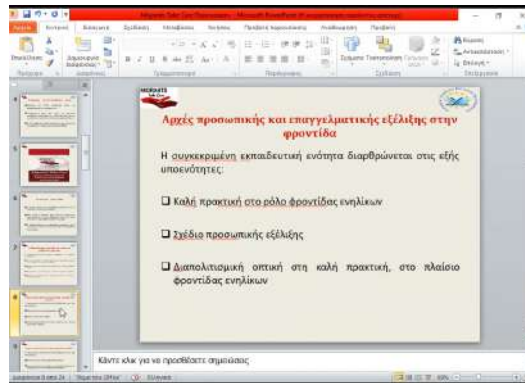
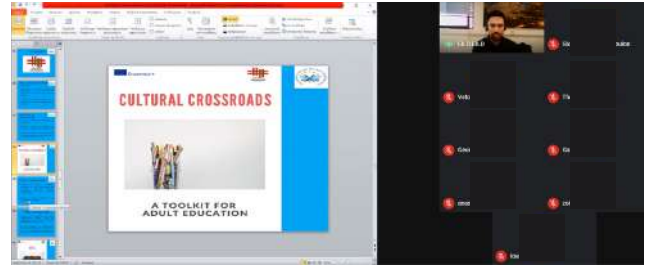


Visual Library of Cultural Heritage develops new skills sets for the participants to access different forms of culture. They are involved in practical and creative workshops, during which they learn and practice the technical process to create digital contents. A four-step approach is applied, tailored to the needs of people with low skills that will enable them to gradually acquire the knowledge. They learn to create new entry points and prototype an AR visual library able to assist people in finding information.

So, in the context of Cheritage we are happy to share that we created the visual library along with our partners. The Institute created the greek material for the library aiming at the provision and the exchange of information about the greek culture.

A concerted effort to preserve our heritage is a vital link to our cultural, educational, aesthetic, inspirational and economic legacies - all of the things that quite literally make us who we are. - Steve Berry
